Dear Wallace—

Bucke writes me about “Homogenic Love” ~ Carpenter’s latest pamphlet ~ and of that B????<sup>2</sup> has claimed in his correspondence with ??? that Carpenter endorses sodomistic [*sic*] practices + claims that Walt himself is to be construed in the same sense. Marion has heard from someone of her friends who interprets Carpenter as B???? has done. Bucke says the charge is impossible of justification. I have never seen the pamphlet spoken of.

It seems that Traubel is speaking of the correspondence between B??? and Sixsmith, but I cannot say for certain. Charles Sixsmith was also a preeminent member of the Bolton Whitmanites.
